3. It is the responsibility of all authors to approve the final version of the article before it is published.
4. He/she must have participated sufficiently in the work to take public responsibility for the content.
5. Those who do not meet the specified number of contributions and conditions should be mentioned in the final "Acknowledgements" section of the article.
6. The terms stated here are regulated in accordance with the rules of the Scientific Committee Editors (CSE) and the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE). Design	Planning methodology to achieve the result	
Supervising	Organizing the course of the project or article, and overseeing and taking responsibility	
Financing	Personnel, environmental and financial support and the provision of tools and equipment	
Tools and equipment	Biological materials, reagents and participating patients	
Data collection and entry	Taking responsibility for conducting experiments, patient follow-up, data management and reporting	
Analysis and interpretation	Taking responsibility for the logical interpretation and presentation of results	
Literature search	Taking responsibility for this necessary job	
Writing	Taking responsibility for the writing of the whole or the body of the article	
Critical review	Reviewing the article not only for spelling and grammar, but also for its intellectual content before submitting.
